Lion Creek, which flows past Napier Vineyards, connects two of our most important wine-producing areas: Napier and Ranzadale. The name comes from the fact that lions used to come to the creek to drink during the hot, \mbox{dry} summer months. Today, Lion Creek usually dries up in summer, leaving behind a riverbed of gravel. The wine is a good choice for all fish and chicken dishes. Pale gold in colour with tropical fruit on the nose, a balanced palate and long finish.
